Members develop musical skills, enrich the cultural life of the community and experience the thrill of having their creativity amplified by a group of enthusiastic young musicians from throughout Burlington.

## Am I ready to be in the ONE Band?

- I can play my instrument and can get it into tune.
- I can make it to at least half of the weekly sessions.
- I am a teenager.
- I know how to play in several different key signatures.
- I like to play in a group setting where I play a lot and listen to others.
- I am willing to take advice and work to improve my playing.

## How is ONE Band different from school band/orchestra?

- More playing, less waiting.
- There is often more room for creativity within your part and in the bands arrangements.
- People dance.
- People sings. Don't be surprised if you do too... in languages you didn't know existed.
- Wind players will sometimes play in interesting keys like D, A, and even E
- Folk music tends to be more repetitive than orchestral music with short melodies repeated.
- Style, arrangements, and other details will be learned by ear or improvised by the group.
- There is usually no conductor.

## How is ONE Band different from a fiddle session?

- We will have sheet music for everything. You don't have to use it if you have a really good ear.
- Fiddles and guitars will sometimes play in challenging keys, like B<sup>b</sup> and Gm.
- Some of the other instruments will be really loud...with spit valves!

## Do I have to live in the Old North End?
