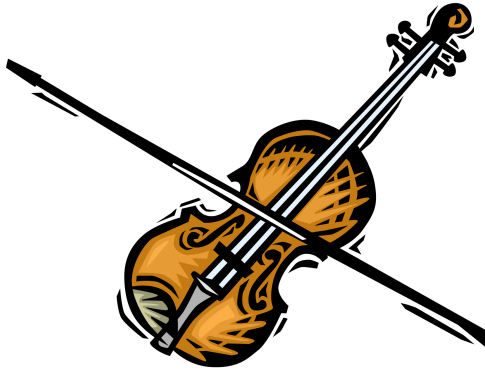


How to get work/study credit to help pay for lessons or rehearsals.



*ONE Band Members and Brian's private students can get work/study credit towards lessons or **ONE Band** participation by helping out with the following tasks. (Parents can help out too.)*

Teach Brian an Awesome Song He Doesn't Know:

- Brian collects interesting and important songs from the neighborhood. He is interested in learning songs in other languages and songs that are important to your family. This involves singing the song repeatedly for Brian, encouraging him as he tries to sing it and then correcting him when he gets it wrong. You can also collect a song from a local resident. Brian will show you how.

Help Teach Music to Kids In the Neighborhood:

- Pass on your knowledge to others. Brian can set you up with teaching opportunities where you can sing or play tunes with others.

Film, Photograph or Record Rehearsals and Performances:

- We need people to record and edit documentation of our performances.

Help Set Up for Rehearsals:

- Chairs, stands, pianos and speakers and music need to be prepared for rehearsals. We especially need well-organized people to help get our sheet music ready.

Help with Neighborhood Gardening:

- There are some community gardens, which need watering and weeding. You can get lesson credit by working on these gardens. Pro tip: There is no better way to meet your neighbors and to collect folk songs than to garden in public places.
